OBJECTIVES

This Course has been structured following the parameters of A2 Level according to the Common European Framework of Reference. At the end of this, students will be able to:

- 1. Write about their daily routine ;
- 2. Understand and interact in easy-structured contexts such as a short selfintroduction, asking for something, describing likes and dislikes, their hobbies, their family and future plans.
- 3. Read and understand the meaning of notices, instructions and easy directions.
- 4. Write and reply to an e-mail.
- 5. Asking for information or directions.

6. Extent their lexical set about Engineering and anything linked to the subject chosen by the Students.

CONTENTS

The Course is divided into two macro-areas.

The first one mainly focused on grammar; in these lessons grammar rules are clearly explained (providing examples) and Students can practice immediately by performing the activities provided by a text-book checking by themselves their knowledge and progress. The Course consists of 24 Lessons, 3 of these are mock-tests where the Students are asked to perform a multiple-choice test.

The second one focused on lexical set contextualized in some readings extrapolated from the Internet aiming to learn, as much as possible, words linked with Engineering and consolidating, at the same time, the grammar rules focused during the previous lessons.
