DECREES AS FOLLOWS

Article. 1 - Notice

1. Competitive selections for admission to the PhD programme in Medium and Mediality at eCampus University are hereby announced. 2. The integrated research lines of the PhD are indicated in Annex A.
3. The number of PhD positions available is 8 (6 of which are funded by scholarship and 2 of which are without funding).
4. The course starts on 1/11/2020; the length of the course is three years.

Article 2 - Admission to the course

1. Admission to the course is obtained by passing a competitive exam based on qualifications, research project and interview.
2. The selection procedure is intended to verify the candidate's aptitude toward scientific research and consists of an assessment of qualifications, the proposed research project and an oral exam.

Article 3 - Admission requirements

1. Applicants must hold one of the following qualifications:
 - a) a university degree obtained in accordance with the regulations in force prior to the Ministerial Decree No. 509/99 (pre-reform regulations) or a specialist/master's degree in accordance with the Ministerial Decree No. 270/2004, obtained in Italy;
 - b) an equivalent academic qualification obtained abroad at an academic institution officially recognized and assessed as suitable by the selection board for the sole purpose of access to the PhD course. This qualification must be comparable, for the duration of the course of study, to the Master's degree and must be valid for enrolment in an academic course similar to the PhD in the country where the degree was awarded;
 - c) candidates who do not hold one of the qualifications referred to in the preceding points who declare that they will obtain it by 31/10/2020 at the latest. Should this candidate prove to be eligible and obtain a place in the published merit ranking list, their admission to the PhD Course will be "with reservations". The candidate must present, under penalty of irrevocable loss of the right to enroll, the certificate of the degree obtained or self-certification by November 6, 2020.
2. The candidate must be in possession of the requirements referred to in paragraph 1, letters a) and b) on the date of the deadline for the submission of applications.
3. Candidates with disabilities or with Specific Learning Disorders, according to current legislation, may explicitly request the necessary aids and/or interventions to be able to take the test. The report must be sent by email to both addresses: segreteria.dottorati@pec.uniecampus.it and disabilita.segreteria@uniecampus.it by the deadline of the application, attaching the certification attesting, respectively, their disability/invalidity situation (according to Law No. 104/92) together with the diagnosis (necessary to judge the appropriateness of the request), or the diagnostic certification (DSA - Art. 3 of Law No.170/2010). In addition, these emails must include the declaration, made in accordance with the law, that the attached certificates correspond to the original. The University has the right to evaluate the applications received, on the basis of the current legislation and the indications of the Disability Commission, as well as to request any additional documentation and to verify the truthfulness of the certifications produced.

Art. 4 - Applications and deadline

1. To participate in the selection procedure the applicant must apply, on penalty of exclusion, by certified e-mail (posta elettronica certificata) from the applicant's personal account, to segreteria.dottorati@pec.uniecampus.it before 12:00 (Italian time) on 01/09/2020. The

application must contain the formal elements described in the attached 'Application form' which must be transcribed in the body of the e-mail.

2. The following attachments must be included, in PDF format, in the application sent via certified e-mail to segreteria.dottorati@pec.uniecampus.it, in accordance with the previous paragraph:

- a) curriculum vitae, duly signed, preferably in European format;
- b) the self-declaration in accordance with articles 46 and 47 of the Presidential Decree No. 445/2000, certifying the possession of all the titles contained therein (Annex B);
- c) an original research project, coherent with one of the PhD themes indicated in Annex A; the project may be written in Italian or English, must be no longer than 25,000 characters (including spaces) and must illustrate in as much detail as possible the theme of the research, the current status of studies on the subject, the objectives and methods for achieving them and an essential bibliography. The research project may be accompanied by the indication of up to a maximum of two reference scholars who will send letters of presentation of the candidate to the PhD Office;
- d) a list of any publications submitted as an annex to the application (Annex C);
- e) any scientific publications, up to a maximum of 6, attached to the application, also in PDF format and indicated in the list referred to in the previous section;
- f) a copy (front and back) of a valid identity document;
- g) a copy of an Italian Fiscal Code or Italian National Health Card; for foreign citizens who do not have an Italian Fiscal Code, a personal identification code will be assigned by the University;
- h) copy of the proof of payment of the €100.00 application processing fee, to be paid to the following account:

The payment of this contribution will not be reimbursed under any circumstances.

3. The following applications will not be considered for admissions, therefore resulting in the candidate's exclusion from the selection procedure:

- a) applications which fail to contain all the required attachments (referred to in points (a), (b), (c), (f), (g) and (h) of the second paragraph of this Article) or applications which contain illegible attachments;
- b) applications for which one or more of the documents referred to in points (a), (b) and (c) of the second paragraph of this Article are attached without the original signature of the candidate;
- c) applications from a certified electronic mail address (PEC) not in the applicant's name;
- d) applications received by other procedures than those indicated in this notice;
- e) applications received after the deadline set out in this notice or without the personal details described in the attached 'Application form' (Name, Surname, Date and place of birth and residence).

4. Academic qualifications not enumerated and described in the self-declaration attached (Annex B) will not be taken into consideration for the evaluation of the candidate, and therefore will not contribute to the assessment for selection..

Article 5 - Exclusions in relation to scholarships

1. PhD students enrolled in the same Doctorate Programme and students who have already obtained a PhD are not entitled to access the scholarship.

Article 6 - Admissions Board

1. The Board, appointed by the Rector after consultation with the Teaching Council, is made up of 5 members from the university Professors and Researchers (RTD), including non-staff members of eCampus University, belonging to the macro-sectors consistent with the training objectives of the PhD Course.
2. The Admissions Board may use online tools, in compliance with the activities to be carried out.

Article 7 - Evaluation of qualifications and research project

1. At its first meeting, the Admissions Board shall pre-determine the criteria to be used for awarding scores to the titles, the research project and the oral test, in accordance with the guiding principles and criteria set out in the third and fourth paragraphs of this Article:
2. The evaluation of the qualifications and the research project shall be awarded a maximum of 50 points according to the following criteria:
 - a. up to 10 points per degree grade (average of grades in the case of undergraduates);
 - b. up to 5 points for scientific publications quantified in Annex B (self-declaration) and which are described in detail in Annex C, not exceeding the maximum number specified, including their identification codes (ISSN, ISBN, ISMN), or accompanied by a declaration from the publisher that the text has been accepted for publication;
 - c. up to 5 points for the elements of the curriculum quantified and described in detail in Annex B and composed by:
 - i. Teaching activities within Degree Courses, Postgraduate Diploma, PhD and University Masters at Italian or foreign universities for which the candidate has indicated for each title, in the appropriate sheet in Annex B (Annex B1), all the following elements:
 - academic year,
 - course title,
 - Scientific Discipline Sector code (SSD) of the didactic activity (not applicable in the case of teaching at foreign universities),
 - Credits (ECTS) of the course (in case of teaching at foreign universities indicate, if applicable, the value in ECTS, if not applicable, the number of hours; in case of teaching related to a Course of Studies which belonged to the Italian Pre-Reform University System " indicate the number of hours),,
 - the University at which the didactic activity took place; - the Faculty and/or the Department to which the course belonged;
 - the Degree Course in which the teaching activity took place, - the teaching method must belong to the following categories: online teaching, classroom-taught or other modalities.
 - ii. Training and/or research activity carried out at Universities or at qualified Italian or foreign institutions, in relation to which the candidate has indicated for each qualification, in the appropriate section of Annex B (Annex B2), all the following elements:
 - title of the training and/or research activity,
 - year(s) of attendance/participation.
 - institution where the activity took place.;
 - iii. Participation in national and international research groups for which the applicant has indicated for each title, in the appropriate sheet in Annex B (Annex B3), all the following elements:

- year,
 - title of the research group,
 - the nature of the research group to be chosen from the following alternatives: national/international,
 - the institution in or for which the research activity was carried out,
 - the role assumed in the research group;
- iv. Participation as a speaker at congresses and conferences for which the candidate has indicated for each title, in the appropriate sheet in Annex B (Annex B4), all the following elements:
- title of the congress/convention,
 - title of their relation,
 - the year and place of the event,
 - the institution where the activity took place,
 - the nature of the event to be chosen from the following alternatives: national/international;
- v. Language skills declared in the appropriate sheet in Annex B (Annex B5) and only if, for each language indicated, the following elements have been indicated:
- the working language in question (Italian does not need to be indicated),
 - the CEFR level,
 - whether the level held is certified or not and, if so, the date of attainment and the certifying institution.
- d. up to 30 points for the research project.
3. If the maximum number of 6 publications is exceeded, the Admissions Board will consider the first 6 publications on the list.
 4. The University reserves the right to conduct appropriate checks on the truthfulness of the content of the self-declarations and to act within the terms of the law if false declarations are uncovered.
 5. It is not permitted to make reference to documents or publications submitted to Public Administrations and/or in other admissions procedures, nor is it allowed to produce documents after the deadline for the submission of applications.
 6. Considering what has been outlined in this Notice of Competitive Selection, the educational activity carried out abroad and the foreign qualifications that are not accompanied, in the manner indicated in the following paragraph, by suitable documentation and translation will not be taken into consideration for the purposes of evaluation. No translation is required if the document is written in English.
 7. The documents referred to in the previous paragraph and any translations thereof, must be attached in PDF format to the application, and the list of documents sent must be reported and described in the appropriate sheet in Annex B (Annex "B6").
 8. All applicants with a minimum score of 35 will be invited to the oral entrance exam.

Article 8 - Invitation to the oral entrance exam and assessment

1. Candidates admitted to the oral entrance exam will be invited by means of a notice sent via certified email (PEC) to the same address used by the candidate to submit the Application, with at least 10 days' notice and, by the same deadline, by publication on the University's institutional website in the notices and competitions section.
2. The evaluation of the oral test allows a maximum score of 50 points according to the following criteria:
 - a) presentation and discussion of the research project (up to a maximum of 30 points);
 - b) presentation of previous research experience (up to a maximum of 5 points);
 - c) presentation of motivations for the specific choice of topic for the PhD (up to a maximum of 5 points);

d) assessment of knowledge of the English language (up to a maximum of 10 points).

Article. 9 - Merit ranking list and assignment of scholarships

1. Candidates with an overall score of less than 70/100 are not considered eligible.
2. On the basis of the overall marks awarded, the Admissions Board shall draw up the merit ranking list of the successful candidates unanimously, or by majority decision.
3. In the event of a tie, the younger candidate shall prevail.
4. PhD scholarships shall be awarded to candidates in the order in which they are ranked.
5. Positions not covered by scholarships shall be assigned to eligible candidates until they are exhausted.
6. Winners who fail to register by the fifteenth day following publication of the ranking list on the website shall be considered as renunciantees.
7. Following renunciation by a winner, the relative position, with or without a scholarship, will be assigned to the next eligible candidate placed in a winning position in the ranking list. In this case the registration must be completed within 5 working days from the date that will be indicated in the notice of succession sent by certified email (PEC) to the address used by the applicant for the submission of the application.
8. Places that may become vacant within one month from the beginning of the first year of the course due to cancellation of the course are assigned to those who are eligible in the ranking list. As far as the communication modalities of the succession and the deadlines for completing the registration are concerned, the provisions of the previous paragraph shall apply.
9. The ranking is valid only in case of renouncement of the call by the winning candidate(s), or if the candidates fail to commence the course.

Article. 10 - Terms of procedure

1. The Admissions Board shall conclude its work in accordance with the regulations and/or ministerial instructions.
2. In the event of irregularities or formal defects, the Rector shall return the documents to the Board assigning, at the same time, a peremptory deadline for regularisation.
3. The acts of the Commission consist of the reports of the meetings, including the opinions expressed for each candidate.
4. The acts are approved by Rector's decree within 15 days of delivery.
5. The final report and the ranking list are published on the University website.

Article. 11 - Civil servants

1. Civil servants admitted to PhD courses are granted, for the normal duration of the course, the leave provided for by collective agreement or, if they are public law employees, they can take extraordinary leave for study purposes, in accordance with the requirements of the Administration, pursuant to art. 2 of Law No. 476 of 13 August 1984, and subsequent amendments, with or without grants and unless expressly waived, only if they are enrolled for the first time in a PhD course, regardless of the disciplinary field.

Article 12 - Enrolment

1. Winning candidates must register no later than the fifteenth day following the date of publication of the ranking.
2. Candidates not yet in possession of the admission requirement at the time of application (if they are in a useful position on the list for admission to the PhD course) must send, by 13:00

(Italian time) of 6/11/2020, by certified email (PEC), certification or self-certification of the qualification obtained, under penalty of forfeiture of admission.

3. Candidates with a degree obtained abroad must send the following documentation to the PhD Office within 4 months of enrolment, under penalty of forfeiture of the PhD and restitution of any scholarship payments received:
 - a) certificate of achievement of the degree with the list of examinations taken, translated and legalized in Italian;
 - b) "declaration of equivalence of qualification", issued by the Italian diplomatic-consular representation of the country in which the qualification was issued, which must show that the qualification held is valid "in loco" for enrolment in an academic course similar to the PhD.

Article 13 - Contributions

1. PhD students are required to pay € 16.00 for stamp duty and the annual fee of € 2,500.00 for the year 2020/2021.

Article 14 - Scholarships and budget for research activities

1. In accordance with the Ministerial Decree of 25 January 2018, the scholarship amounts annually to of € 15,343.28, and is subject to National Insurance dues (INPS - Gestione Separata, see article 2, paragraphs 26 and following, of Law No. 335 of 8 August 1995 and subsequent amendments and additions).
2. Scholarships are paid in deferred monthly installments; the first installment is paid following a declaration of regular attendance issued by the Coordinator of the Teaching Council .
3. Scholarships may not be cumulated with other scholarships for any reason whatsoever awarded, except those awarded by national or foreign institutions, which are useful to supplement the research activity of the doctoral candidate with stays abroad.
4. The amount of the scholarship shall be increased by 50% for any period of stay abroad, lasting no less than one month; the increase shall be granted for a number of months which may not exceed half the entire duration of the PhD. The stays abroad may benefit from additional mobility grants, to be paid by the sending/receiving Departments or by third parties under agreement.
5. Starting from the second year, each PhD student is guaranteed, within the existing financial resources in the budget of the subjects accredited under current legislation, a budget for research activities equal to 10% of the amount of the grant. If the doctoral candidate is not evaluated positively for the renewal of the scholarship the unused 10% remains available to the institution for the same purposes.
6. The PhD student who is not a recipient of a scholarship may receive external grants or other forms of support.
7. In the event of any incompatibility with the scholarship, the amount of the scholarship for the period for which it was received must be returned.
8. The scholarship is confirmed for the following academic year, provided that the doctoral candidate has completed the program of activities planned for the previous year, verified according to established procedures and maintains full administrative regularity.
9. Waiving the continuation of studies or of the scholarship alone entails the obligation to repay the amounts received in the year to which the renouncement refers.

Article 15 - Rights and duties of PhD students

1. Admission to the PhD involves an exclusive, full-time commitment, without prejudice to the possibility of a specific discipline in relation to the provisions of article 12 of Ministerial Decree No. 45 of 8 February 2013. The PhD student cannot be simultaneously enrolled in another Doctoral Programme, Degree Course, Master or Specialization Course, in Italy or abroad, without prejudice to any other situation authorized by the Ministry. Furthermore, the

PhD student may not have professional or work commitments; any authorization to carry out work activities may be issued by the Collegio as long as they do not hinder the participation of the PhD student in the activities foreseen by the PhD Course.

2. All PhD students are subject to annual verification of the completion of the program of activities planned for the previous year. Failure to pass the annual check implies forfeiture of the PhD, with the obligation to return the scholarship for the current year, where granted.
3. Doctoral students, as an integral part of the training project, may carry out, following authorization from the Doctoral Teaching Council and without this entailing an increase in the scholarship, tutoring activities for students attending the Bachelor's and Master's degree courses as well as, within the maximum limit of 40 hours (Article 12 paragraph 2 Ministerial Decree No. 45/2013) in each academic year, supplementary teaching activities.
4. The legislation pertaining to the right to study provided for by Legislative Decree No. 68 of 29 March 2012, as well as the provisions for the protection of maternity pursuant to Ministerial Decree No. 247 of 12 July 2007, are extended to PhD students, in accordance with the procedures regulated therein.
5. The Doctoral Programme is suspended in cases of maternity, paternity and illness, as well as for the performance of a period of study or work that is not incompatible with a subsequent resumption of the PhD course, subject to authorization by the Doctoral Teaching Council. During the periods of suspension, the scholarship is not paid. Periods of suspension must be fully recovered in the manner provided by the Doctoral Teaching Council
6. The Doctoral Teaching Council includes a representative of the PhD students for the management of teaching and organizational problems.

Art. 16 - Attaining the title of PhD

1. The title of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) is awarded following the positive evaluation of a research thesis that contributes to the advancement of knowledge or methodologies in the chosen field of investigation.
2. The PhD thesis, accompanied by a summary in Italian or English, is written in Italian or English. The thesis is accompanied by a report by the doctoral candidate on the activities carried out during the PhD course and a list of any publications.
3. The thesis is assessed by at least two highly qualified professors, it may include professors from foreign institutions, not including the professors who participated in the admission to the PhD nor those appointed by the Doctoral Teaching Council. The external evaluators express a written analytical judgment on the thesis and propose its admission to public discussion or postponement for a period not exceeding six months if they consider significant additions or corrections necessary. Once this period has elapsed, the thesis is in any case admitted to public discussion, accompanied by a new written opinion by the same evaluators, rendered in the light of the corrections or additions made.
4. The public discussion takes place in front of a Commission, appointed by the Rector on the proposal of the Collegio, comprising a minimum of three members identified among university professors and university researchers (RU), contracted researchers (RTD), including foreign researchers, specifically qualified in the relevant sectors. The majority of the Commission is made up of professors external to the University. For those candidates to whom the College has granted the possibility of acquiring the qualification of "Doctor Europaeus", the Commission must be constituted as provided for by current legislation. In the case of specific agreements on co-defence, the Commission shall be constituted according to the modalities provided for in the agreements themselves. The costs relating to the mobility of the members of the Commission shall be covered by the Doctoral Programme.
5. At the end of the discussion, the thesis, with a reasoned written collegial judgment, is approved or rejected.

6. Within thirty days of the discussion and approval of the thesis, the University shall deposit a copy of the thesis, in electronic format, in the ministerial database, pursuant to art. 14 of Ministerial Decree no. 94 of 2013. Subject to the Collegio's authorization, parts of the thesis may be made unavailable in relation to the use of data protected as trade secrets in accordance with the regulations in effect. The thesis must be deposited with the Central National Libraries of Rome and Florence.
7. The title of PhD is issued by the Rector who, at the request of the interested party, certifies the attainment of the qualification. .
8. The additional certification of "Doctor Europaeus" may be issued by the University in accordance with the regulations in effect and the provisions of the University Regulations on the PhD programme.

Art. 17 - Processing of personal data

1. Personal data will be processed in accordance with the provisions of the European Data Protection Regulation no. 679/2016 ("GDPR"), as well as the free movement of such data, which provides for the protection of persons and other subjects regarding the processing of personal data. eCampus University, as "Data Controller", will process the personal data provided in accordance with article 13 of Legislative Decree No. 196/2003 "Privacy Code" as well as article 13 of the GDPR, therefore exclusively for the purposes of the notice and the data collection in question, about which one can request specific information from the Administrative Director. Personal data will be subject to processing operations in compliance with the above mentioned regulations and the confidentiality obligations that inspire the activity of the Data Controller. Such data will be processed both by computer and on paper and by any other suitable support, in a legal and regular way for the purposes indicated in the notice itself and for the possible establishment of a working relationship between the Parties, in compliance with the security measures provided by the GDPR. At any time the interested party may exercise his/her rights towards the Data Controller. The data collected will be kept for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which they are processed ("principle of limitation of storage", art. 5, GDPR) and/or for the time necessary for legal obligations. The verification of the obsolescence of the stored data in relation to the purposes for which they are collected is carried out periodically.

Art. 19 - Final provisions

1. For anything not specified in this Notice of Competitive Selection, please refer to the regulations in effect and the University Regulations for the PhD.
2. An appeal against this act may be filed within 60 days before the Lombardy Regional Administrative Court, Milan, or an extraordinary appeal to the President of the Republic within 120 days.

Text and texts: Translation, rewriting, adaptation; Construction of transmedia and cross-media content (storytelling and cultural products); Orality, writing and textualisation; Philosophy of hypertext; Imitation, reuse, refunctionalisation and plagiarism (old and new dimensions of copyright); Dissemination, circulation and sustainability of texts (manuscripts, documentary sources, art collections, audiovisual products, media industries); Cultural systems and products (economic, organisational and market dimensions, sustainability, circular economy, public support and consequences of cultural policies).
